TOUR ITINERARY

- After a short introduction to the area of Ueno- and an obligatory mention of Ueno's fascination with pandas we take a short walk through the Ameyoko market- Tokyo's last existing black market. Your volunteer-guide will provide information on the Allied occupation of Japan which lasted until 1952 and explain how decisions made back then influence the meals you eat as a visitor- and the meals enjoyed by Japanese school children today.
- We then visit a school-themed restaurant for a sit-down meal where you can enjoy a typical & surprisingly tasty Japanese school meal.
- After the meal your guide will escort you back to the JR Okachimachi station/Panda Square. For anyone interested in spending the rest of the evening at the casual outdoor drinking bars of Ameyoko our guide will happily suggest a place!
